Voice Celebration Workshop with Deva Premal & Miten at the Kashi School of Yoga Sunday, November 18th II:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.

The workshop at Kashi will consist of two parts: Satsang: Meditation with Music and Chanting from 11am-12:30 pm, and Voice Celebration from 2-5pm. "When was the last time you really opened your voice in joy and sang from your heart?" Deva Premal asks. "This workshop is for people who have a longing in their hearts to sing "YES" to life, a longing to sing "THANK YOU!" to life, a longing to open the door to their own inner being, to their own inner peace," she adds.
