The Gayatri Mantra

Om bhur bhuvah svah Tat savitur varenvam Bhargo devasva dhimahi Dhivo vonah prachodavat

The Gayatri Mantra appears in the Ria Veda in a form of twenty-four Sanskrit sullables. Called the "Master Mantra" and the "Mother of the Vedas," it also contains all powers of all mantras as well as all knowledge. Its primary application is for illumination of the intellect which can, when enlightened, contain immeasurable knowledge and a vast understanding of spiritual power. Those who have attained the full fruit of this mantra are in the company of the highest beings in the universe.

The Gavatri Mantra (Wolfgang, 1964)

The Gavatri mantra is the oldest and most powerful of all mantras. Its quality is to purify not only the singer, but also the listener, creating a tangible sense of wellbeing in whoever is exposed to it. Translated, it means: May all beings on earth attain Enlightenment, but as with all mantras, the meaning of the Sanskrit is not as important as the effect the vibrations of it have on the body and energy centres.

Miten recalls when Premal sang the Gavatri Mantra for The Essence CD. "We actually recorded this album in my mother's apartment - the same one in

which I was born - where my parents had sung those mantras to me all those years before. It was Winter time, and I remember when Premal finished singing the Gayatri Mantra there being such a beautiful silence in the room. And since that day I feel Premal's voice has been graced by God. It's much more than mere technique. We all had goose bumps listening to her sing."

"What I admire about Premal most is that she has no ego around her music" he continues. "That's what really touches me - the lack of ego. She comes from such a deep, silent place inside, with the ability to access an expression of deep devotion, which we all recognize in ourselves, but may have difficulty articulating".

Says Premal "It's like we've been given a beautiful plant to take care of, and we just do our best to make sure it's happy; we water it, and then we celebrate it as it grows".

"I wake every morning feeling like I'm living in a miracle - where spirituality, creativity, work, and love. have all come to mean the same thing. My life has been shaped by mantra: I have hecome their servant " Deva Premal

Deva Premal & Miten

Deva Premal and Miten's music is an invitation into the nature of love. devotion, and consciousness, and an expression of spiritual devotion, through song and chant. Deva and Miten have been living and playing together since 1991, first meeting in India where their music arose from the shared love of their Guru Osho. Through their experience of meditation in the ashram and encouraged by Miten. Premal began singing harmony with him. Later she found her true expression through the rediscovery of the mantras she'd chanted as a child with her father in Germany, which included The Gavatri Mantra.

Premal's albums, 'The Essence', 'Love Is Space', and 'Embrace' have topped New Age charts and popularity polls in yoga studios and healing centers throughout the world. Her latest album 'Dakshina' leapt to No. 1 in the Amazon New Age charts on the first day of its release and - unheard of for a chant album - soared to No. 13 in the mainstream chart

Miten, originally from England, was a singer-songwriter in the 70s, opening for such groups as Fleetwood Mac. Lou Reed and Rv Cooder. He later discovered the nower of meditation and left the world of rock 'n' roll behind.
